While the weather has been keeping me inside I decided I needed to organize my fabric. I've been working on this for about 6 weeks now and have wrapped almost 1,000 pieces of fabric on card stock. I figure I'm about halfway through my stash, and it's been a lot of fun seeing what I have. I usually buy smaller cuts of fabric like fat quarters or half yards, so it made sense to me to do this. I bought heavy weight card stock and cut them in half with my rotary cutter. I then fold the fabric until I get a good pile. Then I wind it around the cardboard. This has kept me busy while watching TV in the evenings. I have gone through several totes of fabric and have found a

lot of fabric I never even knew I had, which I guess is understandable since I inherited a lot of fabric from my mother, and I've been collecting for nearly 40 years! Once I get it all wrapped, I will have to sort it and line it up on bookcases so I can see what I have.

I'm hoping this organization will help me with both picking out fabric for a project, and also help me keep my room neater. Does anyone else have an organization process they'd like to share? I would love to write about it in an upcoming newsletter.

Lots of things are happening later this summer and fall and I've been given info and registration form for Quilt Day at the Fair, QANA festival info and registration forms, and BSQ Retreat 2023 info and form. MEALS PROVIDED: We will be providing Friday, Saturday, and Sunday lunch. Breakfast is included with hotel stay



Quilts and Needle Arts Festival

2023 Entry Requirements

All quilts entered must accompany a \$5.00 per quilt charge.

- All quilts must be constructed of three layers of fabric and contain some amount of quilting. While quilting done for hire is permissible, commercially produced quilted items do not qualify.
- Any quilted item that has not been entered in a previous QANA show is eligible.
- An identification label which included the entrant's name, address, telephone number and the name of quilt must be sewn onto the back of every quilt entered in the show. Bag/totes must have an identification label which includes the entrant's name, address, and telephone number. To label these items, you can baste a muslin label or tape the information in the bag which can easily be removed.
- A 4" sleeve must be sewn to the back of the quilt. If your quilt is more than 90" long, place the top edge of the sleeve 90" from the bottom of the quilt. Entries without a sleeve will NOT be accepted. (Please see instructions on back for making the sleeve.)
- All quilts must be clean, free of smoke, pet hair or odors. Soiled or quilts with odors will not be eligible for display or judging.
- The QANA committee reserves the right to reject any unqualified or misrepresented quilt show entry. All decisions of the QANA committee and judges are final.
- Quilts that do not meet the requirements listed will not be judged or exhibited. Entrants will be notified of disqualification as soon as possible.
- All entries for the 2023 festival will be judged as Peoples' Choice during the show from those in attendance. **** only one voting sheet per person per day accepted.
- Quilt show entries may be offered for sale but must remain on display until the end of the three-day show. All transactions are the responsibility of the individual owners.
- All quilts will be handled with the greatest care; however, the QANA will not be responsible for damage of any kind. NOTE: your quilt show entry may be covered under your homeowner's insurance policy.
- Once you've paid your fees for your quilt entries, you will receive 1 free ticket to enter the quilt festival. It may be used only once.

Quilt sleeve Instructions

Cut a piece of fabric 8.5" wide and equal in length to the width of your quilt. Make a one-inch hem on the two short edges of the fabric strip. With wrong sides together, sew along the long edges of the strip using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Turn the sleeve right side out and press. Slip

stitch both top and bottom edges to the top of your quilt back, leaving the ends open so that a rod may be inserted into the sleeve to hang the quilts for display. **For quilts longer than 90 inches, please make sure that the top edge of the sleeve is sewn 90 inches from the bottom of the quilt!**
